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## From the Editor ...



One of the great religious controversies that has raged back and forth for centuries has once again raised its diabolical head. When to observe the Passover is being questioned again! Satan the devil greatly desires to distort the facts surrounding the correct time for the commemoration of the Lord's True Passover and thereby confuse God's people. But, for those who love the Word of God, and look to it for direction and TRUTH, the study of the correct time for Passover becomes more clear and understandable!

Last month's article in The Midnight Cry, entitled The Quail of Exodus 16, by Wallace Lawton, confirms the exact time for the slaying of the lambs as commanded by God, and for the observance of God's True Passover! As originally instructed by God in Exodus 12, the slaying of the lambs was to be done between the evenings of the 13th and the 14th of the first month of the year, Nissan (Abib).

In this month's issue, Mr. Lawton examines the true meaning of some New Testament scriptures that have been rendered by the translators as contradictory to very plain statements from the Old Testament. The Bible does not contradict itself—it is TRUTH! But the translators, as sincere as they may have been, were subject to Satan's wiles and their own tradition. Nevertheless, time will tell—and TRUTH will stand! Mr. Lawton brings this out in his article, Jesus' Last Passover: How and When was it Observed.

We are very happy that we can offer these informative, life-saving articles, and all of us can "grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ" (II Pet. 3:18). With Passover only weeks away, here is a short summary of some of the vital truths we have learned or reviewed recently about the important subject of God's True Passover:

- The Hebrew word ba erev is translated in many places in the Old Testament as the English word even or evening. However, by allowing the Word of God to define ba erev, we found, in last month's article, The Quails of Exodus 16, that ba erev means sunset—the end of the day!
- In the article, it is also made plain that another Hebrew term, ben ha arbayim, is mistranslated as even or evening by Strong's Exhaustive Concordance, in eleven different places in Moses' writings. Yet it is correctly translated as dusk by the Jewish Publication Society, or as twilight in Young's Literal Translation of the Bible. The 1965 Bible in Basic English also properly translates ben ha arbayim in Ex. 12:6 as: "Keep it [the Passover lamb] till the fourteenth day of the same month, when everyone who is of the children of Israel is to put it to death between sundown and dark."

# Jesus Last Passover When and How Was It Observed?

In the article in last month's Midnight Cry, entitled "The Quails of Exodus 16," the Biblical use of the Hebrew terms ben ha-arbayim and ba-erev were carefully explained. Our merciful God had the miraculous account of the quails of Exodus 16 preserved in Scripture to prove conclusively that the correct time for keeping the Passover service is immediately after sunset (ba erev) of the 13th of Nisan, which is then the time period of dusk (ben ha-arbayim)—beginning the new day of Nisan14.

We hope the article did prove to you the exact time God intends for the Passover to be observed! And we knew a follow-up article would be required about the New Testament Scriptures, because there is almost as much confusion surrounding the New Testament Passover as there is about the Old Testament Passover.

The Truth of God's Word is available and can be understood, in spite of mistranslations or misrepresentations. The truth of Jesus' last Passover has been faithfully preserved in the New Testament, just as the truth about the Old Testament Passover has been preserved. Satan may try to bury the truth under an avalanche of lies and false doctrines, but the Truth of God always prevails! Yet people choose to believe false doctrine because they want to cling to their traditions, and do not love the Truth of God! (Mark 7:7-13 and II Thess. 2:10)

Luke 22:7 in the KJV reads, "Then came the day of unleavened bread,

when the Passover must be killed."
This sentence has caused some confusion! It is certain that this sentence does not refer to the first

day of Unleavened Bread because the Feast of Unleavened Bread begins after, not before, the Passover.

In the first century, it was commonly known that "the day of the unleaveneds," as in Luke 22:7, was the 14th of Nisan—Passover day!

G. Amadon, in an article titled "The Crucifixion Calendar," pointed out the error of those translators who translated this verse to read, "the first day of the festival."

But on what authority should the Hebrew translators, as Salkinso and Delitzch, introduce the word chag [a Hebrew word for "feast"], into these texts when the corresponding Greek has no word for "feast" and speaks only of the "first of the unleavened bread"—a common expression for the Jewish 14th with practically all first century writers (Journal of Biblical Literature, vol. LX111, 1944, pp. 188-189, emphasis added).

## JESUS' LAST MEAL REALLY WAS THE PASSOVER

Jesus Himself tells us that He kept THE TRUE PASSOVER, as recorded in the Gospel of Mark. Scripture shows that there is no question whatsoever that our Lord observed the true Passover at the beginning of the 14th, twenty-four hours before the Jews' Passover.

Let's begin in Mark 14:12:

And the first day of unleavened bread, when they killed the Passover..."

This verse is a mistranslation as proven by the Old Testament Scriptures! The Passover was killed on the 14th, and the first day of the Feast of Unleavened Bread began on the 15th.

Therefore the literal translation of verse 12 from the Greek should be "the first day of the unleaveneds"! The Passover was to be killed between the evenings of the 13th and the 14th, as proven in last month's article. Then the daylight portion of the 14th was the first day of the unleaveneds, defining the first day of the year, when the people were required to "unleaven" their dwellings in preparation for the Days of Unleavened Bread—as commanded by God in Exodus 12.

Let's continue in Mark 14, verse 12: "...when they killed the Passover..." This expression is most revealing because of the intrinsic meaning of the Greek verb. The English word translated they killed comes from the Greek verb ethuon. The verb root is thuo. The verb ethuon reflects the following case and action:


- 3rd person plural they;
- Imperfect meaning an action not yet completed, but taking place at that very moment – were killing;
- Active indicative being done personally at that moment by the subject - they.

A literal translation of the Greek would be as follows:

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And on the first day of the unleaveneds, when they were killing the Passover...

The original Greek text shows that the lambs were being killed at that very moment, as Jesus sent His disciples into the city of Jerusalem!



"Go into the city, and you will meet a man carrying a pitcher of water - follow him! And wherever he may enter, say to the master of the house, The Teacher says, where is the guest-chamber where I may eat the Passover with My disciples?"

These lambs were not being killed by the priests at the temple; that would be done the next afternoon, for the 14th/15th temple Passover.

The word "they" in this verse can only refer to those who were killing the Passover lambs at that moment on the 14th. "They" could not possibly be referring to the priests at the temple, because the temple-sacrificed Passover lambs were not slain until the next afternoon.

The only logical conclusion is that "they" refers to those who were killing the Passover lambs at houses or inns, where the domestic Passover of the 14th would be kept. The lambs were being killed at the beginning of the 14th, according to the statutes and ordinances of Exodus 12. This was the exact moment that Jesus sent His disciples into Jerusalem, "...when they were killing the Passover..."

There can be no doubt whatsoever as to the time of day these verses are specifying! The disciples knew that it would soon be time to eat the Passover, but they did not know where Jesus wanted them to make the necessary preparations. Since the killing of the domestic Passover lambs was happening before their very eyes, the disciples asked this urgent question, as the properly translated combined verses of Mark 14:12 and Luke 22:7 convey:

On the first day of the unleaveneds in which it was obligatory for the Passover to be killed, when they were killing the Passover, His disciples asked Him, 'Where do You desire that we should go and prepare the Passover that You may eat?

The Gospel accounts clearly show that the domestic Passover was a common practice! It is also apparent in these accounts that the disciples were accustomed to keeping the domestic Passover, as indicated by their question, "...Where do You desire that we should go and pre-

pare the Passover that You may eat?"

It should not surprise us to learn that the domestic Passover was common at that time. The temple could not possibly accommodate

the vast numbers ..... lambs required for everyone to keep the Passover within the allotted time. It would have taken several davs for all the lambs

of people and The Gospel accounts clearly show that the domestic Passover was a common practice!

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to be killed before the altar. The domestic Passover was not only common, but it was, of necessity, the predominant practice.

When we examine all three Gospel accounts which record Jesus' instructions to His disciples, it is obvious that Jesus kept the domestic 14th Passover. The evidence is overwhelming!

### **Matthew's Account**

Now on the first of the unleaveneds, the disciples came to Jesus, saying to Him, "Where do You desire that we should prepare for You to eat the Passover?" And He said, "Go into the city unto such a man, and say to him, The Teacher says, My time is near; I will keep the Passover with My disciples." And the disciples did as Jesus directed them, and they prepared the Passover (Matt. 26:17-19).

Not once is the temple mentioned, nor is the temple - killed Passover lamb remotely indicated in these accounts. There can be no doubt that Jesus kept the domestic Passover on the 14th day of the 1st month, as commanded in Exodus 12.

In spite of these clear, easy-to-understand Scriptures, the advocates of a 15th of Nisan Passover refuse to acknowledge Jesus' own words. In their study papers and doctrinal presentations, these direct statements of Jesus about His last Passover are either ignored or deliberately left out!

In summary, the New Testament clearly reveals that:

- Jesus kept THE PASSOVER, not some other meal.
- It was a proper, Scripturallybased Passover.
- He ate it on the correct day, the 14th of Nisan, at the proper time.

• He used a domestic, homesacrificed lamb, not a temple-sacrificed lamb.

There is no indication in the Scriptures that Jesus ever kept the Passover on any other day than was explicitly commanded in Exodus 12. If He had done so, He would

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# Prepare for the Now Chu Spring of Call to Christel Holy Day Season The tion in the Christel The

I have found it rather strange that as we approach the start of God's Holy Day season, our minds have been directed to the end of God's Holy Day season. Of course, I'm talking about our preparation to keep the Feast of Tabernacles. It is very necessary to start thinking about the Feast this year and finalise our plans. There is nothing wrong in forward planning for the Feast, but now we do need to get our minds back to the soon coming start of God's Holy Day Plan.

Creation is the proof of the existence of God! Creation identifies God! The Sabbath is a weekly memorial of creation. It is a weekly reminder of God's power to create; therefore, it identifies God to us. The weekly Sabbath keeps us in

the true remembrance and true worship of the true God. No other day but the 7th day of the week could have that great significance and meaning. It was designed to keep us in the true worship of God.

Now, in like manner, God gave His Church 7 annual Sabbaths. These Holy Days were given to keep us constantly in the understanding of God's Plan of redemption—all the way from the sacrifice of Christ, to the putting out of sin, the receiving of God's Holy Spir-

it, the return of Jesus Christ, the restraining of Satan, and the giving of the

Holy Spirit to all mankind.

The whole story of the redemption of man was to be acted out in these Feast Days, year after year continually. They have vitally important symbolism and meaning, and we learn by doing! That is, we grow in understanding of their meaning by keeping and living out these days as they come to us. God wants to impress the meaning of these days on His people. Herbert W. Armstrong wrote:

Now when God made the Sabbath for man, He gave man a rest day carrying great significance and purpose. To His Church in the wilderness. God said that the Sabbath was a covenant sign between Him and His people. A sign is a supernatural proof of identity. It is the sign by which we know that He is God...Now in like manner, when God gave His Church seven annual Sabbaths, God, in His wisdom, had a great pur-

pose... For these annual days picture the different epochs in the plan of Spiritual creation - mark the dispensations, and picture their meaning... God's feasts, or holy days, or Sabbaths, were commanded to be kept year after year, and forever!... Thus God purposed to impress the truths these "high" Sabbaths picture upon all the minds of His children through all time, keeping His Church in the true understanding of His plan! (Pagan Holidays-or God's *Holy Day –Which?* HWA)

Three times, or three seasons in a year, God commands we appear before Him (Deut. 16:16). We are approaching the first of these seasons now – the Spring Holy Day season. There are three major events in God's Spring Holy Day season, all of which appear in the 1st month of God's sacred calendar. The three major events are, of course, the Passover, the Night to Be Much Observed, and the Days of Unleavened Bread.

Let's look at some ways to prepare for and successfully keep these three major events of the Spring Holy Day season.

## **PASSOVER**

# Passover

The Passover occurs every year on the 14th of Nisan, and is kept just after sunset the previous evening. How do we prepare for this most important event?

For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do show [proclaim] the Lord's death till

We have an individual responsibility to take more profound stock of our lives over the past year, and implement change where necessary.

As we grow in deeper and knowledge spiritual things, our ability to see ourselves accurately becomes more acute. We see things about ourselves and

our nature that we never saw at baptism. This is right! It is progress! It is what God intended.

Wherefore the law is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good, Was then that which is good made death unto me? God forbid. But sin, that it might appear sin, working death in me by that which

is good; that sin by the commandment might become exceeding sinful (Rom 7:12-13).

Paul is asking if that which is good (the law) brings death to

him. He answers himself by saying that it was sin. Sin brought death to him, by the law. Why? In order that sin might be shown to be exceedingly sinful!

When Paul received God's Holv Spirit and began to grow, he found that his more profound knowledge of God's spiritual law made sin appear a lot worse than he first imagined. And so it is with us. The longer we live with ourselves in the flesh, the more our knowledge of God's Law convicts us of the sinfulness of our human nature.

As we approach the Passover, we have had one more year to live with ourselves. God is now asking us once again to partake of the broken Body and shed Blood of Jesus Christ.

Has this past year convinced you that you need the sacrifice of Christ even more profoundly than ever before? Yes, you've overcome sin. Yes, you've grown in Bible understanding. Yes, you understand government more. Yes, you get on better with other members. But have you grown in personally knowing that you need Jesus Christ more than ever before? God wants us to approach the Passover with the most earnest and heartfelt desire for the forgiveness of Christ. No one who has lived another year in the flesh with the presence of the Holy Spirit can approach the Passover without a deeper and more

How do we eat and drink unworthily? It means in an unworthy manner. No human being is worthy of Christ's sacrifice. "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God" (Rom 3:23).

We can, however be worthy in our attitude. Taking the Passover worthily means we enter into the service with deep respect for Christ's sacrifice. We must not be casual. We must focus on Christ's sacrifice, as we did prior to baptism. We must look at the way we are presently living our lives. Are we overcoming sin? There is much to do.

What is our responsibility, given Christ's sacrifice? Paul says we must examine ourselves. Salvation is not a group affair. We have an individual responsibility to take stock of our lives over the past year, and implement change where necessary. Christ is knocking on your spiritual door. How are you going to respond to Christ?

When we examine ourselves, we should measure ourselves against Jesus Christ, not other human beings.

yourselves, Examine whether ye be in the faith; prove your own selves. Know ye not your own

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man, that they could not keep the Passover on that day: and they came before Moses and before Aaron on that day ... And Moses said unto them, stand still, and I will hear what the LORD will command concerning you. And the LORD spake unto Moses saying ... The fourteenth day of the second month at even they shall keep it ... (Num 9:6-11).

Please note: you may not plan to skip the first and take the second Passover. You plan to take it on the 14th of Nisan. Only unforeseen circumstances that cause you to miss the Passover enables you to take it one month later. Those not able to travel to a Passover service (housebound) will be given instructions on how to keep it at home.

Always remember that this is a very solemn occasion and should be approached with deep respect and reverence.

## THE NIGHT TO BE OBSERVED

Following the evening of the Passover, we keep the Night to Be Much Observed. It will be kept at the very start of the 15th of Nisan, which is a Holy Day.

The night is to be "much observed." This means we should pay careful attention to detail in our observance of this evening. Some may feel that, although it may be an enjoyable evening, it is not as important as the Passover or the other Holy Days. But that is

Days of Unleavened Bread. It commemorates the Israelites walking out of Egypt by night (Ex 13:3-4).

We are told to remember this day, just like Malachi tells us to remember what Christ taught through the Elijah remember to where it all began and to hold fast!

The ancient Israelites had been held in bitter slavery. They groaned for deliverance. And God delivered them on the night after Passover - the Night to Be Much Observed. Egypt is a type of sin. Think about it. Walking out of Egypt was the most emotional, exhilarating, joyous experience of their wretched lives.

God wants this night to be a joyous, happy occasion. We should celebrate because we, too, have been delivered from Egypt—spiritually! Because of Christ's sacrifice, God requires that His Church also celebrate this fantastic occasion as a memorial of that night.

Let's consider some practical, yet

necessary, aspects of this occasion. This night is actually the beginning of the first Holy Day.

We should dress in our Sabbath best. We should follow the Bible principle of dressing properly for special occasions (Matt 22:11-13). Try to meet with other members of the Church if at all possible. If nobody invites you, invite someone to your place. Gathering in

the wrong way to look at it. All of God's Holy Days, including the Passover and Night to Be Much Observed, are part of ONE PLAN! Remove one Holy Day and the plan fails. Keeping the Passover alone is not enough. We must observe this 2nd night to properly keep the

someone's home is best, but if not possible, a nice restaurant would be appropriate. Try to get a private room away from the public. Loud music, interruptions and background noise will greatly detract from the evening. Make sure the manager knows our dietary requirements, including the need for unleavened bread and unleavened products only. Remember, this is not a worldly party. It should be dignified. We should rejoice, but be moderate with our eating and drinking.

Rejoice in the Lord alway: and again I say, rejoice. Let your moderation be known to all men. The Lord is at hand (Phil. 4:4-5).

Remember, also, there will be a double service the next day, so don't stay too late.

A word of caution here—some of the split-off groups have gotten away from diligently keeping God's Holy Days, including the Night to Be Much Observed.

...let us truly realise that Satan, the devil, would use all of his vast powers of deception to confuse God's people about the accuracy of God's Calendar. He is doing this today by deceiving a number of individuals and groups into producing their own calendars and dates for God's Holy Days. In doing so, they are arrogating God's authority - an extremely dangerous thing to do! Mr. Herbert Armstrong faced the same disputes and arguments in his day that are being brought up Mr. Armstrong again today. proved that the Hebrew Calendar was God's Calendar back in the 30's and 40's, and the Church of God has followed it since then (The Plain Truth about

*God's Calendar*, Mr. Robert Ardis, page 7).

Although we may look on this evening as a social gathering, it is more a gathering of God's Church for a specially commanded purpose. Just as we would not invite a non-member mate or a member of a split-off group to services, neither should we invite them without ministerial approval, to the Night to Be Much Observed. This is a very special occasion for members and prospective members of God's Church. However there are certainly circumstances where someone else would be welcome, but first seek approval.

This is a night to discuss spiritual subjects. We need to leave our day-to-day cares out of the conversations on this night. God provided this occasion for us to truly celebrate coming out of the slavery of sin. Because of what God has done for us, we owe it to Him to celebrate with a high hand the Night to Be Much Observed. By doing so, we will be giving great honour to God.

Seven special days with great meaning and a Holy Day at each end!

Seven days shall ye eat unleavened bread; even the first day ye shall put away leaven out of your houses: for whosoever eateth leavened bread from the first day until the seventh day, that

bead symbolising and picturing COMPLETE putting away of sin or, in other words, THE KEEPING OF THE COMMAND-MENTS!

These FEAST DAYS picture the KEEPING OF THE COMMAND-MENTS!... To what extent shall we

put away sin? Not partially, but COMPLETELY! And, as leaven is also a type of sin--leaven puffs up, and so does sin--and, as SEVEN is God's number symbolizing COMPLETENESS, we are to follow the Passover with the seven Days of Unleavened Bread!

The process of removing leaven from our homes, and the preparing and eating of unleavened bread, are the physical symbols of this festival. Of course, it is sin we must be putting out, but God places much emphasis on the symbolism of unleavened bread. God's command is unmistakable. Remove the leaven! We may not eat it or have it on our premises. If we want to be diligent in clearing out sin, then we must be diligent in removing leaven for this seven day period.

Now notice that it is not enough to just remove leaven – we must replace it with food that represents righteousness.

And on the fifteenth day of the same month is the feast of unleavened bread unto the LORD: seven days ye must eat unleav-

ened bread (Lev 23:6).

For seven days we must eat unleavened bread, it is after all the feast of unleavened bread!

Now notice that it is not enough to just remove leaven – we must replace it with food that represents righteousness.

This festival, however, is so much more than ridding our homes of leaven, and consuming only unleavened products. It is an annual God-given opportunity to: Remove, Replace, Re-educate, Rejoice.

REMOVE ALL that leaven.

REPLACE With a variety of unleavened products that will remind you of God's righteousness.

RE-EDUCATE Don't miss this opportunity to learn more about this festival.

**REJOICE** Because God has revealed

the meaning of this festival to us.



#### From the Editor

- For Ex. 12:6, the KJV renders ben ha arbayim as evening, but in their margin it correctly states the term as between the two evenings.
- The Holy Scriptures make it very clear that Passover occurs on the 14th of the first month and the Days of Unleavened Bread commence on the 15th. Num. 28:16-17 declares: "And in the fourteenth day of the first month is the Passover of the LORD. And in the fifteenth day of this month is the feast: seven days shall unleavened bread be eaten."
- The Passover on the 14th and the Days of Unleavened Bread beginning on the 15th are two different occasions, but unleavened bread is used in both of them. On the Passover, the unleavened bread represents the broken (ripped and torn) BODY of Jesus our Savior. The unleavened bread eaten during the seven Days of Unleavened Bread pictures sincerity and truth!
- The original Passover lambs were to be slain ben ha arbayim (between the two evenings) as the sun set (ba erev) on the 13th of the first month. Again, see last month's article, The Quails of Exodus 16.
- The lamb was then prepared and roasted, and its blood was smeared on the doorposts and lintels of the homes of the Israelites.
- The Passover lambs, after being roasted, were eaten in haste around 10 to 11 PM, with bitter herbs and unleavened bread.

- The Eternal, as the Death Angel, "passed over" the homes that were "under the blood of the lamb" at the midnight hour of the 14th. Notice Num. 28:16 again: "And in the fourteenth day of the first month is the Lord's PASSOVER"! The Bible says He "passed over" on the 14th not the 15th!
- During the original "Pass Over", if there were any rebellious and stubborn "firstborn" who insisted on keeping the Passover on the night of the 15th, they died in their stubbornness by the hand of God at midnight on the 14th. What a lesson for today!
- The Israelites were commanded to be in their homes while the Lord "Passed Over" at midnight, and to stay in their homes until morning (Ex. 12:22).
- Pharaoh called for Moses in the night to come to him (v.30-34), but Moses could not leave his house till morning, as had God commanded.
- As the morning arrived, the Israelites left their homes and spoiled the Egyptians in haste, preparing to leave Egypt (v. 35-36). The Israelites had been doing this since God had brought the plagues upon Egypt, but apparently completed their spoiling of Egypt as they prepared to depart (see Ex. 3:21-22 and 11:1-3).
- Preparing to leave as the morning of the 14th came was a monumental task of organization, although it must have been preplanned. And let's add here that, IF the Passover had occurred at midnight of the

- 15th, they could not depart by night as the scriptures tell us, because they were not to leave their homes until morning! Therefore, they would be leaving in the daylight portion of the 15th and the night time portion of the 16th—Biblically incorrect and impossible!
- Two to three million Israelites, now released from slavery, in addition to their flocks and herds, had to gather in an orderly fashion and begin their march out of Egypt. The scriptures are plain that they left Egypt on the NIGHT of the 15th: "And they departed from Rameses in the first month, on the fifteenth day of the first month; on the morrow AF-TER the Passover the children of Israel went out with an high hand in the sight of all the Egyptians. For the Egyptians buried all their firstborn, which the LORD had smitten among them: upon their gods also the LORD executed judgments" (Num. 33:3-4).
- Add to this Ex. 12:41-42: "And it came to pass at the end of the four hundred and thirty years, even the selfsame day it came to pass, that ALL the hosts of the LORD went out from the land of Egypt. [For these MILLIONS to leave in an orderly fashion, it required the daylight portion of the 14th to assemble, and ALL of the night of the 15th to have ALL of the Israelites make their march out of Egypt.] It is a night to be much observed unto the LORD for bringing them out from the land of Egypt: this is that night of the LORD to be observed of all the children of Israel in their generations."

- This night to be observed is the beginning of the Days of Unleavened Bread, the 15th of Nisan—the day that begins at sunset on the "morrow" AFTER the Passover (Num. 33:3). It is Biblically impossible for the "Pass Over" to occur on the night of the 15th, with the Israelites staying in their homes until MORNING, and still leaving during the same NIGHT of the 15th!
- Jesus Christ is the Lamb of God slain from the foundation of the world (Rev. 13:8) and He is our Passover (I Cor. 5:8). He changed the emblems of the Passover from the slain lamb to the unleavened bread and wine, representing his beaten and torn body and His spilled blood.
- Jesus kept His last Passover at the precise time between the evenings of the 13th and the 14th, and true Christians are commanded to keep it as He instructed on that Passover evening.
- The apostle Paul was inspired to write in I Cor. 11:23, "For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, That the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed..." Jesus our Lord on the true Passover Night became the Passover Lamb by changing the emblems to symbolize His Body and Blood. He tells us to observe this in memory of Him.
- Prov. 14:12 tells us: "There are ways that seem right to a man but the ends thereof are the ways of death." No commands or instructions are given for commemorating 3:00 PM on the afternoon of the 14th as the

time of Jesus' death! The Passover lambs were to be slain between the evenings of the 13th and 14th —not at 3:00 PM! The priests in the temple sacrificing lambs at 3:00 PM on the 14th is a TRADITION of the Jews, instituted hundreds of years after the commands in Exodus 12. Nowhere in the Bible are there instructions to observe 3:00 PM, but to some very confused people, it seems so right to do it.

• There are no commands to observe Jesus' resurrection either, but it seems so right to more than a billion people as they celebrate the pagan Easter in "honor" of Jesus. All of these ways of man and his traditions produce vain and confused doctrines of demons, but in their self-righteous deception they love those Satan-


inspired traditions more than they love the Word of God (II Thess. 2:9-11)!

Mr. Lawton closes his article this month by quoting from I Corinthians 5. I will do this, too, using part of verse 7 and all of verse 8: "...For even Christ our Passover is sacrificed for us: Therefore let us keep the Feast, not with old leaven, neither with the leaven of malice and wickedness; but with the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth."

Have a truly inspiring Passover on Sunday evening, March 28; then, the next night have a wonderful Night to be Much Observed, which begins the seven Days of Unleavened Bread.

### Forecast: Flood risk for third of U.S.

More than a third of the contiguous United States faces a high or above average flood risk this spring, the National Weather Service reported Tuesday.

"As the spring thaw melts the snowpack, saturated and frozen ground in the Midwest will exacerbate the flooding of the flat terrain and feed rising rivers and streams,"

"We are looking at potentially historic flooding in some parts of the country this spring," Jane Lubchenco, head of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, said at a news briefing while presenting the government's spring outlook.

# U.S., U.K. Move Closer to Losing Rating, Moody's Says

March 15 (Bloomberg) -- The U.S. and the U.K. have moved "substantially" closer to losing their AAA credit ratings as the cost of servicing their debt rose, according to Moody's Investors Service.

Under the ratings company's so-called baseline scenario, the U.S. will spend more on debt service as a percentage of revenue this year than any other toprated country except the U.K., and will be the biggest spender from 2011 to 2013, Moody's said today in a report.

"We expect the situation to further deteriorate in terms of the key ratings metrics before they start stabilizing," Cailleteau said. "This story is not going to stop at the end of the year. There is inertia in the deterioration of credit metrics."

## Norway doomsday seed vault hits 1/2 million mark

OSLO, Norway – Two years after receiving its first deposits, a "doomsday" seed vault on an Arctic island has amassed half a million seed samples, making it the world's most diverse repository of crop seeds, the vault's operators announced Thursday.

Located in Norway's remote Svalbard archipelago, the Svalbard Global Seed Vault is a safeguard against wars or natural disasters wiping out food crops around the globe. It was opened in 2008 as a master backup to the world's other 1,400 seed banks, in case their deposits are lost.

# US backs off speedy Iran sanctions promised Israel
